## Town of Westport Island Board of Selectmen, Assessors and Overseers Meeting April 13, 2015

### **Meeting Convened:**

**1.** George called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

### **Business Conducted:**

- **2. Warrant:** George motioned to approve Warrant No. 41 for a total of \$10,981.76 (Payroll-\$700.00; Accounts Payable-\$10,281.76; Ross, 2<sup>nd</sup>; vote: 3-0.
- **3. Board of Selectmen Minutes:** George motioned to accept the minutes of April 06, 2015; Jerry, 2<sup>nd</sup>; vote: 3-0.
- **4. Citizens Issues**: Roger Higgins, as President of the Westport Volunteer Fire Department (WVFD) Board of Directors, sought the endorsement of the Board of Selectmen for a \$1,300 grant to the Lincoln County Planning Commission (LCRC). The grant seeks a structural engineering evaluation of the firehouse, because the WVFD believes that the building faces some critical structural problems. Roger asked for the Selectman's signature on a letter to LCRC Community Development Director Mary Ellen Barnes on behalf of the WVFD. George motioned to approve the request for approval of the grant letter; Ross, 2<sup>nd</sup>; vote: 3-0.

Roger Higgins, as Emergency Management Assistance (EMA) Director, also advised the Board of Selectmen of upcoming Incident Command System Trainings for Elected Officials on April 28 at 6 p.m. at the Newcastle Fire Department or May 12 at 6 p.m. at the Waldoboro Fire Department. This training is required for towns to be compliant with federal eligibility guidelines for federal emergency management funds.

**5. Public Hearing on Map 001, Lot 11 (Gould) Pier, Ramp & Float Application:** George requested that the Board of Selectmen meet at 6 pm on April 20 at the Gould property on Map 001, Lot 11 to hold a public hearing for the Pier, Ramp & Float Application. The Selectmen agreed.
