Town of Westport Island Board of Selectmen, Assessors and Overseers Meeting October 17, 2016

Meeting Convened:

1. George called the meeting to order at 07:00 p.m.

Business Conducted:

- **2. Warrant:** George motioned to approve Warrant Nos. 32 & 33 for a total of \$34,357.61 (Payroll No. 32-\$1,216.14; Accounts Payable No. 33-\$33,141.47); Ross, 2nd; vote: 3-0.
- **3. Board of Selectmen Minutes:** George motioned to accept the Board of Selectmen minutes of October 3, 2016; Jerry, 2nd; vote: 3-0.
- **4. E. Davies Allan Request:** E. Davies Allan came before the Board of Selectmen to seek permission to haul his 70' landing craft out at Wright Landing for repair, using a commercial boat hauler, and place it in the parking area where the floating docks are placed for a duration estimated to be about one month. Mr. Allan's request was denied by the Board of Selectmen because it conflicted with the Ferry Landing Ordinance regarding storage of a boat overnight.
- **5. History Committee Update:** History Committee Co-Chair Mary Coventry advised the Board of Selectmen that the History Committee membership for the 2016-2017 plan year had been updated to move Jeff Tarbox from an associate member to a regular member. He will take over the remaining two years of Sandra Besecker's term which ends in 2018; Sandra has agreed to become an associate member. George motioned to accept this arrangement; Jerry, 2nd; vote: 3-0.
- **6.** Community Association Request for a Christmas Tree for the Community Church: Community Association co-chair Laurie Jaramillo requested permission to have an outside lighted Christmas tree at the Community Church. The lighting ceremony will take place December 4th, and then it will be left on until Christmas for a few hours each night using a timer. George motioned concurrence; Jerry, 2nd; vote: 3-0.
- **7. Sand & Salt Facility:** George advised that a Planning Board public hearing would be held at the location of the Sand & Salt Facility on October 28 (Friday) at 3 p.m.; the bid opening is still scheduled to take place at 4 p.m. on October 20 at the Town Office.

- **8. C.A.I. 2016 Parcel Layer Change Request Contract:** George motioned to approve signing the \$500.00 C.A.I. Contract for the 2016 Parcel Layer Change Request which was submitted by the Town; Ross, 2nd; vote: 3-0.
- **9.** Invoice for Mediation of the Lilly/Wollins Dispute from the Barry Kohler Consulting Firm: Lawyer Bill Dale advised that the \$500.00 invoice should be paid even though we had not requested the consultation. The Board of Selectmen reluctantly agreed to pay the invoice.
- **10. Excise Tax Collector's Request for Sick Time Off:** George motioned to allow Dedee to have the day off on November 3 for a doctor's appointment; Jerry, 2nd; vote: 3-0.
- **11. Staff Request for Changed Office Hours on Tuesdays:** George advised that Dedee and the staff requested a change to the Tuesday office hours from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. starting Tuesday, November 8. George motioned concurrence; Ross, 2nd; vote: 3-0.
- **12.** Plumbing Code Manual for the Local Plumbing Inspector (LPI): George motioned to accept Plumbing Inspector Jerry Bodmer's request to purchase the latest version of the International Association of Plumbing and Mechanical Officials (IAPMO) Internal Plumbing Code (\$114.00) because it is a "read only" document on line and cannot be downloaded; Ross, 2nd; vote: 2-0. Jerry abstained.
