## Definition of Maine Resident

Resident means a citizen of the United States who is domiciled in Maine or an alien who has been domiciled in Maine for one year.

These requirements must **all** be met to be a resident of Maine:

1. If registered to vote, registered in Maine;
2. If licensed to drive, made application for a Maine driver's license;
3. If owning a motor vehicle or vehicles located in Maine, registered each vehicle in Maine and;
4. In compliance with the Maine income tax laws. A child is considered a resident if the parent(s) or legal guardian is a Maine resident.

### Important information for Senior Lifetime Licenses:

Applicants ages 65 & over may purchase the lifetime license anytime within the year of their birthday.

For example, if you turn 66 during the current year, you would qualify at the 66 Year Old price.

## *What is a Resident Lifetime License?*

Lifetime licenses for hunting, fishing, trapping and archery are now available to residents of Maine who are 65 years of age or older or who are 15 years of age or younger.

Applications **MUST** be received by Inland Fisheries & Wildlife or postmarked **BEFORE** the child's 6th or 16th birthday.

Your investment in a lifetime license for yourself or as a gift, will allow the bearer to fish, trap and/or hunt for their lifetime, regardless of where they will live in the future. Once purchased, a resident lifetime license is valid for the life of the holder no matter where the holder lives.
